ompetitors from around the world competed in the 2022 ISA International Tree Climbing Championship (ITCC) on 9-11 September under the canopy of Fælledparken located in Copenhagen, Denmark. This competition was the first ITCC since the COVID-19 pandemic, and proved to be just as exciting as always. This event was also the first time ITCC was held in Europe in more than a decade. The last time the competition was held in Europe was in 1998 in Birmingham, England. Additionally, a new rulebook was introduced at the 2022 ITCC.

The 2022 host, the ISA Denmark Chapter, were incredible partners in coordination logistics and organizing Arbor Fair. The event offered a variety of activities at Arbor Fair, featured dozens of industry and local vendors, and attracted attention from the public which provided the opportunity for ISA to educate the public about the important work arborist do in their communities while introducing them to an exciting and unique sport.

Throughout the weekend, the aweinspiring feeling of camaraderie continued
while the climbers participated in several
events—Aerial Rescue, Work Climb, Ascent,
Belayed Speed Climb, and Throwline. After
the preliminary events, the climber's scores
from each event are combined, and the male
and female competitors with the highest
combined scores move on to compete in the
